ROUND 1 :

5 Seeded groups of 9 players will play a Round Robin best of 5 frames. The 7 top placed players from each group will proceed to round 2.

ROUND 2 :

4 groups, 3 of 9 players and 1 of 8 players will play a Round Robin best of 5 frames. The 4 top placed player from each group will proceed to round 3.

ROUND 3 :

The top 16 seeded players will join with the 16 remaining players from the 1st and 2nd rounds. They will be split into 4 groups of 8 playing a Round Robin best of 5. The 4 top placed players from each group will proceed to the Open Team Finals.

OPEN TEAM FINAL

16 players playing full Round Robin best of 5. The order in which players finish is how they will be selected for the 1996 Open Team for the National Championship. The top 4 placed players will proceed to the Open Singles Final.

OPEN SINGLES FINAL:

The top 4 placed players from the Open Team Final will play a full Round Robin best of 9 with the player finishing 1st being selected as the ACT Open Singles Representative for 1996.
