- Steve Woods has requested a wild card entry in to the Open state team based on previous performace (as per Matt H)
 - o David Kilpatrick finished ahead of SW on state selection
 - o Wild card is for use of players who are unavailable to play due to National representation, extended to physical inability to play
 - o The State team is not unanimous on inclusion of SW
 - Team would prefer 9 players to 10
 - o Inclusion of SW would represent selection of 11th before 10th
 - o SW would represent asset to team
 - Similar justification used to support Matt Harmon inclusion
 - Arguments presented that the situation different between SW and MH
 - o MH unable to play trials due to injury
 - o SW played and was unsuccessful at team selection
 - o No current information on player availability of team
 - SW inclusion would be at expense of existing member
 - o President statements (supported by Secretary)
 - Decision to include MH set a precedent for selection in the absence of trail performance
 - The decision to include MH was an error, which would be perpetuated by SW inclusion

- As committee is unwilling to revisit MH inclusion, consideration must be given to SW request
- o ACTEBA should send best available team, rather than the team based on selection trials
 - Wide support for this position
 - MH will be tested to ensure capability to play
- o DK has played nationals previously
- o SW intends to attend nationals to compete in the singles title
